A couple of years ago we looked at the Exodus story over several weeks. Deborah and the children made a huge fabric map showing Egypt and the Red Sea and added to it each week as the story progressed. My abiding memory is of watching Obi Wan Kenobi leading the motley crew of Israelites across a shiny blue fabric sea away from the Egyptian army led by Darth Vader and Long John Silver (we used Joel's Lego people to act out the story). But more seriously, we did learn lots about Egypt and visited the Egyptology section of our local museum and reflected on the story from the perspective of both the Israelites and the Egyptians. We ended the series with the story of Joseph which coincided with the celebrations of 200 years since the end of slavery, so we did quite a lot of reflecting on what freedom looks like.
